RAIL NEWS

The Railroaders Museum in Altoona has announced that <u>ex-Pennsy K4 #1361</u> will be shipped back from Steamtown to Altoona to be assembled and put on static display. It was sent to Scranton 14 years ago and more than \$1.6 million was spent on the project with little to show. Hopes are that the locomotive will be in running condition someday.

Norfolk Southern plans to <u>expand its Harrisburg Intermodal Terminal</u> facility that presently consists of 16,500' of pad track and parking spots for 1160 trailers. The expansion will consist of 2 additional pad tracks- one 2700' long and the other 8700' long. An additional support track, 9000' long, paved areas for an additional 910 trailers, new in and out-bound gate areas, and reconfiguration of the existing support tracks to support the improvements. Norfolk Southern has <u>only 56 locomotives left in storage</u>. They previously sold 35 GE C39-8's to National Salvage & Service (NSSX) and 15 GE C39-8's to Ed Berrier & Asso. (EBBX) to be shipped to Peru. An interesting note - NS still has 204 units on active roster remaining in Conrail Blue paint.

Norfolk Southern also got some good news recently when PECO Energy announced that they will <u>delay</u> the retirement of the coal-fired generating plants at <u>Cromby's and Eddystone</u> for a year or two.
